Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store employing only 4 people. Overall sales for that initial year amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and different parts. Within 5 years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 employees and their annual sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is amongst the top worldwide manufacturers within the material handling industry.

Design and production of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively engage in better business possibilities. All through the final 60 years, the industry of material handling has grown into a really complex area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the best supplier of lift truck attachments and numerous associated products. The company feels confident in their skill in order to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive within the international market.

All through the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to manufacture, design, and sell its hydraulic attachments. A brand new facility was built in 1956, to accommodate all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's current head office. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total staff reached a hundred and eighty staff and sales had reached practically two million three hundred thousand dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio a second manufacturing facility was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the international world of the material handling industry when the business established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In the year 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing facilities throughout the continental USA to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are fabricated internationally because of many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This plant is built to be the essential customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to acquiring 5 companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international best in forks.
